
Need for Expansion: Post-Panamax Ships

- Post-Panamax: A new generation of vessels that exceeds the current capacity of the Canal's lock chambers.
- Experts estimate
 Post-Panamax
 vessels currently
 account for 16% of the
 world's container fleet
 and 45% of the
 capacity of the fleet.



• Mærsk Line's Gudrun Mærsk has the capacity to carry close to double the capacity of the current class of vessels that transit the pre-expansion Panama Canal


